SELECTION PROCESS FOR ADMISSION

1. For the students of Vidyasagar University and autonomous college(s) affiliated to Vidyasagar University (80% seat)

- Selection will be made strictly on the basis of marks obtained in the concerned CGPA. In case of equal CGPA, immediately preceding Examination are to be considered for ranking.
- As per order of the Govt. of West Bengal 80% of total seats in each subject will be reserved for the students of Vidyasagar University and autonomous college(s) affiliated to Vidyasagar University.
- Quota for SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B/EWS will be considered as per Govt. rules. Number of seats (SC, ST, OBC-A, OBC-B & EWS) will be calculated and considered separately for 80% seats and 20% seats. Fraction of 0.5% or more will be rounded to the next whole number.
- 5% of each category (Gen/SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B/EWS) will be reserved for Differently Aabled Persons (DAP) candidates.
- Normally 80% seats will be for the students of the Vidyasagar University.
This 80% and 20% may be relaxed in case of non-availability of the applicants in either category.

2. Seats for other University including Vidyasagar University and Autonomous Colleges under Vidyasagar University (20% of Total Seats)

- 20% of the total seats are reserved for the students of other Universities/Institutions
 - Percentage of marks obtained in UG(Hons.) (Part – I, Part-II & Part-III taking together) for the annual system,
OR
 - Equivalent percentage of marks converted from CGPA, in case of semester (CBCS) system.
- In case of a tie, marks obtained in the immediately preceding Examinations are to be considered for ranking.

- ii) Minimum 45% marks is required for General Category to apply for admission in Bengali/Education/English/History (20% seat) and minimum 40% marks is required for SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B/DAP candidate.
3. The admission will be held as per the Rules and Regulations framed by the Vidyasagar University and Government of West Bengal.
4. Online provisional admission will be done based on the merit list thus published through the college PG admission portal.
5. The verification of testimonials & other documents for provisionally admitted students will be initiated after completion of admission process.
6. The admission will be cancelled if a student remains absent from classes for consecutive ten days from the date of admission without any intimation to the Principal/concerned Head for PG studies.

N.B. :

- (i) **Application form, if not properly filled in, is liable to be cancelled.**
- (ii) **Students, who passed the undergraduate course with concerned honours subject in the year 2022 & 2023 are eligible for apply.**
- (iii) **If at any stage, it is found that a candidate has concealed, suppressed or distorted any information/fact, in their application form, his/her admission to the university, if granted, shall stand cancelled.**
- (iv) **The e-mail ID and Mobile number provided by the candidate cannot be changed till completion his / her course of study in the college.**
